At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed public meeting on March 19, 2018 with a quorum being present, a quorum being 4 Commissioners, Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC") 6D voted 5-0-0 for the motion to support the request by Forest City Washington (the "Applicant") for a five-year extension of the existing approval for the temporary parking use for the existing parking lots on the properties known as Parcels F, H/I, and Q in The Yards.
