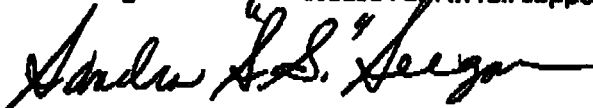
The relief you are requesting:

Pursuant to CHAPTER 30. ZONING COMMISSION RULES OF PRACTICE AND PROCEDURE, Section: 3024.
