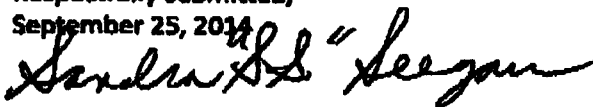
I also oppose the late filing of a statement by Commissioner Karlene Armstead filed on September 24, 2014, which I was told last week that the deadline for submitting was September 22, 2014. Moreover, to shed light on the practices of Com Armstead.

I, Sandra Seegars, am the immediate past Chairperson of ANC 8E. While serving as Chair, Commissioner Karlene Armstead was a commissioner for at least one 2-year term, perhaps two 2-year terms. Com. Armstead has always worked independently of the commission. She did not and still does not attend all of the ANC meetings. As her usual practice, after the commission discusses, votes and acts on an issue/motion, she comes weeks/months later to try to regress to the previously moved issue.

By law, the chair person represents the ANC Commission before Zoning. A vote is only taken if the ANC Commission assigns someone else to represent them.

Addressing "WBG Circumventing ANC 8E" as stated by Chairperson Muhammad. Com. Armstead has not been involved with the hearings held at Zoning and missed several ANC meetings. If she met independently with the WBG, it is unknown. She is unknowledgeable about WBG attempting to circumvent the ANC 8E with an agreement they formulated with Brenda Richardson, non commissioner, which was composed using the CBA template that was written and presented to WBG by Chairman Muhammad and community members. Com. Armstead has always been antagonistic towards the majority of the commission, especially the chairpersons, as well as authority figures; and acts enviously because she has always wanted to be the chairperson. Thereto, possible reasons for her late submission.
