On March 5, 2014, the Office of Zoning received an application from Professional Associates and the International Finance Corporation (the “Applicant”). The Applicant is requesting approval of a consolidated planned unit development (“PUD”) to permit the construction of a new 11-story addition to the existing IFC headquarters. The Office of Planning provided its report on April 4, 2014, and the case was set down for hearing on April 15, 2014. The Applicant provided its prehearing statement on May 19, 2014.

The property that is the subject of this application consists of approximately 83,201 square feet of land area and consists of the entire triangular-shaped block that is bounded by K Street N.W., 21st Street N.W., Pennsylvania Avenue N.W., and 22nd Street N.W. (Square 74, Lots 49, 832, and 840). The subject property is zoned C-3-C and is located in the New Downtown Receiving Zone.

The Applicant proposes to redevelop the existing nine-story commercial office building at 21st and K Streets into a new 11-story addition to the existing IFC headquarters.

This public hearing will be conducted in accordance with the contested case provisions of the Zoning Regulations, 11 DCMR § 3022.

How to participate as a witness.

Interested persons or representatives of organizations may be heard at the public hearing. The Commission also requests that all witnesses prepare their testimony in writing, submit the written testimony prior to giving statements, and limit oral presentations to summaries of the most important points. The applicable time limits for oral testimony are described below. Written statements, in lieu of personal appearances or oral presentation, may be submitted for inclusion in the record.

How to participate as a party.

Any person who desires to participate as a party in this case must so request and must comply with the provisions of 11 DCMR § 3022.3.

A party has the right to cross-examine witnesses, to submit proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, to receive a copy of the written decision of the Zoning Commission, and to exercise the other rights of parties as specified in the Zoning Regulations. If you are still unsure of what it means to participate as a party and would like more information on this, please contact the Office of Zoning at dcoz@dc.gov or at (202) 727-6311.

Except for the affected ANC, any person who desires to participate as a party in this case must clearly demonstrate that the person's interests would likely be more significantly, distinctly, or uniquely affected by the proposed zoning action than other persons in the general public. The written report of the ANC shall be filed no later than seven (7) days before the date of the hearing.
