On behalf of the DC Preservation League, I would like to commend the applicants on their continued progress and commitment to the historic preservation elements of this proposed plan. Retention of the eight historic structures, including 911 L Street, shows commitment to retaining the character of the Shaw Historic District.

Of the buildings incorporated in this plan, 911 L Street is arguably the most special, as it is likely one of the oldest, if not the oldest in the neighborhood. Pre-civil war structures are becoming more and more rare in our city and the applicants willingness to preserve it should be praised.

DCPL feels that the inclusion of 911 L Street along L Street breaks up a long façade, gives additional breathing room to the Lurgen Apartment Building and adds to the ever-important pedestrian experience.
