I believe EDENS will provide a balance and it will be right in my backyard! Union Market provides a space for both the urban, hip, party-goer and the moms looking for a place to have fun with their family. I feel like I can go with our without the kids! I don't feel that way at Gallery Place. I feel it serves one type of customer-someone looking for a night out on the town.

The relationship between EDENS and my family is personable and secure. However, what has blessed me the most is that on top of our family relationship, they reached out to determine how they could support my church, New Samaritan. I was surprised because many developers build in a community and assume members of the community want certain perks or support.
