I live down the street from Brookland Manor and oppose the proposed redevelopment.

The August Washington Post article lays out very clearly the indignities that residents have had to face: being sued for eviction for being late on a \$25 rent check, for having an unleashed dog, for having a family member who committed suicide(!). These lawsuits become part of a resident's record and make it harder for them to get housing elsewhere once they are evicted or leave "voluntarily" after months or years of harassment by management. Mid City's protestations, saying "HUD made me do it," ring hollow, and HUD has denied that their policies require a landlord to sue a tenant for \$25 in unpaid rent. The pace of lawsuits has steadily ratcheted up as tenants move out.
