Dear Mr Bello,

This letter is to clarify my prior letter of March 12, 2015 rejecting building permit application B1307755 because the plans supporting that application were stamped by an engineer whose license had been revoked.

The Director of the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs has determined that building permit application B1307755 is rejected, under 12A DCMR §105.3.1, for the failure to submit plans stamped by a licensed engineer or architect in compliance with 12A DCMR §§105.3.10 and 106.1. As a result, any construction at this site will require a new building permit application that complies with the requirements of 12A DCMR §§105.3 and 106, including new plans stamped by the DC-licensed architect or engineer responsible for the preparation of the plans. Any such proposed construction will have to comply with the zoning regulations applicable at the date of application.

You may appeal this decision under 12A DCMR 112.2.1 within ten (10) business days of notice of this decision to the Office of Administrative Hearings, 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 450 North, Washington, D.C. 20001 (tel. (202) 442-9094, fax (202) 442-4789).
