The Office of Zoning has received and reviewed the request for the application cited above, which requests:

Review and approval of a map amendment from the R-4 Zone District to the R-5-B Zone District for property located in the northwest quadrant of the District at 1361 Irving Street, N.W. and 1368, 1370, and 1372 Kenyon Street, N.W., also known as Square 2848, Lots 39, 40, 72, and 838.

The Office of Zoning has determined that your application is complete, that it meets the basic filing requirements, and that the appropriate filing fee has been paid. This application has therefore been accepted for processing.

The Office of Planning (OP) will further process this application prior to it being presented to the Zoning Commission. The initial consideration given to the application concerns whether the Commission should set the case down for a public hearing.
