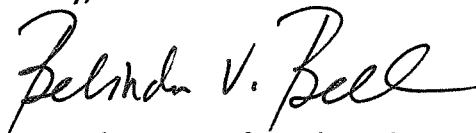
Dear Zoning Commission:

We, the Concerned Citizens of North Michigan Park, are requesting a sixty (60) day extension to submit a response. At the September 22, 2015 Zoning Commission meeting, the Chairman asked the Applicant to consider other options around the idea of the bike/pedestrian pathway to avoid foreseeable future problems. The Applicant said they only needed two weeks to respond. This timeframe was too short. As you know, the ANC did not give approval for the bike/pedestrian path for this project.

On September 28, 2015, the Applicant met with ANC Commissioner Austin, and representatives from Emerson Park and Concerned Citizens of NMP. However, at the meeting, the Applicant did not present any suggestions, ideas, or let us know of any research they had conducted for other options. We started brainstorming. The developers volunteered to consider one idea thrown out at the meeting and get back to us. However, the Applicant did not have enough time to get back to us to discuss the outcome and/or to explore further options before it submitted its October 5, 2015 response to the Zoning Commission. Granting the requested extension would allow more time for all parties to research and discuss other possible alternatives.
