Following the Zoning Commission's discussion on January 29, the ANC has met twice with the Applicant regarding the proposed PUD at 501 Eye Street SW.

While we have begun discussion on the issues we provided in our set-down report, we want to <u>re-emphasize</u> that the ANC and the Applicant, as reiterated in their report to the Commission, <u>still</u> do not see eye-to-eye on the consistency of the Project with both the Comprehensive Plan and "award-winning" Southwest Small Area Plan.

- Consistency with the Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Map designation of a property designated as "institutional" and;
- Recommendation of the SW SAP for "no change" at the current project site and;
- Inconsistency with the surrounding uses (3-story townhouses to the north and west; a park to the south; and a school soccer field to the east); and
- Proximity of the project that has shadow, light and air and noise impacts.

While we welcome the opportunity to continue to dialogue our position on the setdown has not changed.
