As a resident of Penn Branch I would like to voice my support for the zoning amendment of the Penn Branch Shopping Center property. This property is an eyesore and the community needs the space to be revitilized.

On the other hand, it was a terrible idea for the Zoning Commission to encourage a custom zone for this property that will set a terrible precedent city-wide. These changes to MU-4 could have just as easily have been reached via a Planned Unit Development.

I also find it incredibly distasteful that multiple Ward 3 activist groups are here in support of a property in an area they've never been and would never go to, all in order to support their segregationalist agenda. I vehemently oppose Alma Gates' motion for MU-4A to be further reduced in density and immediately implemented city-wide.
