The U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for their review of the Parcel LI 35% Design Submission. Through the design review and comment process, GSA received comments on the submission from the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) and from the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). In addition, the Parcel I 35% Design was submitted to the Commission of Fine Arts (CFA) and the National Capital Planning Commission (NCPC) for advisory review and comment at the November 15, 2018 and December 6, 2018 Commission meetings.
