National Capital Parks-East, an administrative unit of the national park system, requests that the Zoning Commission table review of the application by Kenilworth Avenue Northbridge, LLC to construct a new all-affordable senior assisted living community on Kenilworth Avenue, N.E. in Ward 7 (Case # 19-09). This property is directly adjacent to Kenilworth Aquatic Gardens and recently, the National Park Service has been made aware that there are outstanding resource injuries/violations associated with the subject property that requires further review and investigation. These resource injuries include illegal dumping and damages to forested wetland on NPS property.
