

Chapter 3, Sec. 3.2– 3.11; Chapter 4, Sec. 4.1– 4.2	The two most important parts of the VIA are the Affected Environment and the Environmental Consequences.  Affected Environment This section describes the existing conditions against which the potential effects of a project will be assessed. It includes the applicable visual resource-related LORS and agency management objectives and also provides information about the regional and project landscape.  Environmental Consequences This section describes the visual impacts of a project. It also includes key components such as the scope and methodology used for the impact analysis and a detailed description of the visual characteristics of each alternative. Potential impacts are described in terms of the visual contrasts created by the project components and associated activities; these are typically determined from visual simulations. This section also typically includes a description of specific mitigation measures and a discussion of compliance with all LORS and agency visual management objectives. It should also include visual objectives for adjacent lands.


