Regarding ZC case 19-21, please **do not change** the existing regulations that:

- 1) protect rooftop elements and porches. There are elements that are characteristic of many row house neighborhood homes that should continue to be protected.
- 2) govern the building height of residential houses zoned RF1- RF3. Again, let's preserve the beautiful symmetry of our residential roof lines.
- 3) govern the rear expansion of residences, currently limited to 10 feet beyond an adjoining property.

Washington, DC is an architecturally beautiful city. Please keep the zoning changes incorporated in 14-11 which help preserve this beautiful city for its' residents, and for tourists from all over the world that visit the Nation's Capital.
