Dear Zoning Commission Chair and Members:

The following is an update and revision to the referenced Howard University pending application for a modification to confirm that a barber and hair salon in the University's Drew and Frazier residence halls are permitted accessory uses under the University's Central Campus Plan, (Z.C. Order No. 20-08). Based upon our subsequent consultations with the Office of Planning staff, we believe that the more appropriate relief is an amendment to the Campus Plan that will more broadly permit personal care uses, including the hair styling and care services requested previously, as well as similar personal care services. The proposed amendment will require that such uses be located in University dormitories on the campus and that they exclusively serve Howard University students, faculty and staff. Further, their size shall not exceed three percent (3%) of the subject dormitory's gross floor area.
