

I am one of many DC residents who is concerned about the severe housing crisis confronting our city. We have over 4,000 neighbors who are without housing, and at least 77 of these residents died in DC last year. I believe that is a collective moral failure of all of us who call this city home. I hope DC leaders do not forget about our need to take much bolder action to alleviate and meaningful address the housing crisis, and I hope housing, particularly affordable housing, is considered for this site.

Behind my house on Jenifer Street NW, there is a 9-story building with 160-units dedicated for affordable housing, and I am grateful that building was allowed to be built and make it possible for so many people who lived there over the decades since it was built to be part of our neighborhood and larger DC community.
