DC needs more housing and Ivy City businesses need more customers.

I'm writing as a Ward 5 resident to oppose ZC 24-11. The Office of Planning's report in Exhibit 55 doesn't even attempt to explain how this proposal fits with the District's housing goals. While DC faces a serious housing shortage, OP treats the loss of potential homes here as if it's irrelevant.

This site has been zoned for mixed-use development for over a decade — homes, shops, and walkable streets — not warehouses or factories. Expanding industrial use back to this land is the opposite of what the Comprehensive Plan calls for.

Please reject this proposal and insist on a plan that actually adds housing opportunities along New York Avenue.
