I am writing a letter to voice my support for the 901 Monroe Project. I have lived or worked in the Brookland neighborhood now for 18 years and raised my children here. I have been an advocate for this project since the very beginning when both myself and my very pregnant wife at the time, testified on behalf of this project back in 2011/2012! We have watched the community develop over the past decade plus, with some incredible work that in my opinion has greatly improved the neighborhood from both a quality of living standpoint as well as from a property value standpoint. While it has been encouraging to see this progress and see the gradual improvements, it still feels as though our neighborhood is lagging in its speed of development and improvement rate, relative to many neighboring communities, and the fact that the 901 Monroe block has remained untouched is a reminder of that.
