Hello,

My name is Rasik and I am a resident of Ward 5. I recently had a child and I would love to move into a small townhome but there no small homes within our budget in DC. Sometimes it feels like the American Dream is never going to happen for my generation. So many people I know want to expand their families, but are constrained by the lack of housing options.

That is why I strongly support the proposed text amendment in ZC-25-06. Alley housing can help address affordability, increase neighborhood safety through active usage, and enhance community character.

But DC is in a housing crisis, and we urgently need to build more homes. To help support housing creation, the Zoning Commission should consider:

- 1. Eliminating expensive parking mandates for alley homes.
- 2. Aligning unit limits with the limits of their zones.
- 3. Aligning the height limits of alley homes with their zones.

These changes will help us build a more inclusive, vibrant, and affordable DC.
