I live near alley homes at the intersection of the U St and 14th St corridors. These alley homes, far from detracting from the area, add to its sense of vitality and possibility, and make DC's urban fabric richer and more varied.

I strongly support the proposed text amendment in ZC-25-06. Alley lots can help create naturally affordable housing.

DC is in a true housing crisis, and we need to build more homes ASAP in any way possible. To help support housing creation, the Zoning Commission should strongly consider:

- 1. Eliminating expensive parking mandates for alley homes.
- 2. Aligning unit limits with the limits of their zones.
- 3. Aligning the height limits of alley homes with their zones.

These changes will help us build a more inclusive, vibrant, and affordable DC.
