Good morning,

I live in Bloomingdale and there are a number of "alley homes" in our neighborhood and LeDroit Park nearby. They are a great way to allow for additional housing in a popular and dense neighborhood, using space that is not needed for parking given the ample additional spots to create additional, more affordable homes.

I strongly support the proposed text amendment in ZC-25-06. Alley lots can help create naturally affordable housing.

DC is in a housing crisis, and we urgently need to build more homes. To help support housing creation, the Zoning Commission should also consider:

- 1. Eliminating expensive parking mandates for alley homes.
- 2. Aligning unit limits with the limits of their zones.
- 3. Aligning the height limits of alley homes with their zones.

These changes will help us build a more inclusive, vibrant, and affordable DC.
