Dear Mayor Barry:

Thank you for giving us the chance, at your gathering on September 25,1986, to present our concerns over the delayed down-zoning of the west side of Connecticut Avenue between Chevy Chase Parkway and Military Road.

The recent court action (Chevy Chase Defense Committee vs Mr. Gilbert Oken) confirms the requirement to zone that area conforming to the "moderate density" called for in D.C. Law 5-187. That requirement dates back to a 1978 WACC recommendation to the predecessor of the Office of Planning and Development, signed by our Ward 3 ANC Chairpersons (among them, Chuck Clinton, Lindsley Williams, Carol (Gidley) Currie, Ginny Spevak, and myself).

In that document, paragraph 21 covers the area in question, urging down-zoning to R-3, based on a 1968 court action sustaining a protective covenant providing for single-family homes. On several occasions, ever since, we have urged this down-zoning to be ordered. It would have saved the community considerable expense. However, we are pleased to have your assurance that the issue will be pursued with an appropriate recommendation to the Zoning Commission.

We do see some urgency to proceed quickly, in order to forestall any other activities which might force the neighbors into further expensive and unnecessary litigation.
