On November 3, 1986, at its regular monthly meeting, the Zoning Commission initiated action to consider the comprehensive rezoning of the Connecticut Avenue Corridor between Calvert Street and Western Avenue, N.W., pursuant to the Generalized Land-Use Element of the Comprehensive Plan. The Commission requests OP to report to the Commission at its December 8, 1986 meeting, and propose a hearing date that would permit the Commission to consider this case based on the above-mentioned approach. The Commission believes that the Spring Valley Shopping Center (49th St. & Mass. Ave., N.W.) should not be considered in the context of the rezoning of the Connecticut Avenue Corridor.
