This letter is in support of the petition filed with you by the Cleveland Park Historical Society in regard to case #86-26, a zoning adjustment in that area. Your attention I know has been called to the traffic, parking and pollution to name only a few of the impending problems attending proposed and future construction under the C-2A zoning classification. I do favor appropriate development as well as holding with the city's Comprehensive Plan which calls for "low density.... neighborhood centers." C-1 not C-2A is the fair and appropriate classification for commercial development along Connecticut and Wisconsin Ave. in the Cleveland Park area.

I have had the good fortune to live at my present address since 1953. I realize of course that change is inevitable but would appreciate careful consideration of the family neighborhood character of this section of the city.
