I have never written a letter to a government official before, but feel I must write to support the Cleveland Park Historical Society and ANC 3 proposal to modify zoning for the commercial area between Macomb and Porter Streets.

I moved to Cleveland Park nine years ago because it had a sense of community missing in most "neighborhoods" in the city. Because of the low scale buildings, the area has predominately small stores which provide service not available in the chain stores which predominate large development. Certainly the neighborhood can't tolerate any increase in traffic. Please support a controlled growth for Cleveland Park.
