Dear Mr. Williams:

I strongly support the proposed downzoning of Woodley Park. Having lived in the neighborhood for six years I have seen considerable growth of commercial activity, such as the new Sheraton hotel, and in the process I have seen a deterioration of the quality of life for those of us who live here.

We have a good balance now. I'm concerned that would be lost if the small restaurant district at Connecticut and Calvert is replaced by office buildings, or if existing commercial development extends off Connecticut.
