Dear Petitioners:

This is in reply to your letter dated July 27, 1987, requesting that the Zoning Commission for the District of Columbia initiate a zoning map amendment case regarding Squares 2106 and 2204, which abut Connecticut Avenue in the Woodley Park area, and urging the Commission "to take preemptive action by scheduling a hearing..." with respect to Square 2204.

The Commission considered your request at its monthly meeting on August 3, 1987. The Commission had previously set the monthly meeting on September 14, 1987, as the date to receive and act upon the Office of Planning's recommendation whether to hold a hearing on issues arising from this area and other Connecticut Avenue areas. At that time, the Commission will determine which areas will be set for

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hearing, and if so, the extent to which the various areas will be considered at the same or different hearings.

The Commission has requested the Director of the Office of Planning, Fred L. Greene, to alert the Commission promptly, if it appears necessary for the Commission to meet to address Square 2204 before September 14.
