As residents of Cleveland Park since 1962, we urge the Zoning Commission at its July 7th hearing to reduce the Planned Unit Development guidelines for the commercial area on Connecticut Avenue N.W. between Macomb and Porter Streets to a height limit of 40 feet and FAR limit of 2.0. This will bring the PUD guidelines into line with the height limit that the Zoning Commission has recommended preliminarily and the FAR limit that we urge it to set (from 2.5 to 2.0) in the overlay zone and still allow ample development beyond existing buildings. Anything beyond that would be a contradiction of the Comprehensive Plan's designation of this commercial area as a "low-density, local neighborhood center."
