Therefore, I hope that the Zoning Commission will uphold the Comprehensive Plan's designation for the Connecticut evenue/Cleveland Park area which allows the kinds of redevelopment that will generate revenue but not overwhelm residential neighborhoods or drive out local merchants and businesses. I request that the Zoning Commission limit PUDs in this area to 40 feet and 2.0 FAR.
