As a resident of Cleveland Park (3311 Rowland Place, N.W.), I wish to emphasize to you my strong opposition to PUD high-rise office development in our area, which already suffers from serious traffic, parking, and pollution problems. You are aware that the current Comprehensive Plan states that Cleveland Park should remain a "low-density, local neighborhood center."

In light of the foregoing, I urge that the position of the Cleveland Park Historical Society be adopted to limit PUDs to 40 feet and 2.0 FAR. This would facilitate the protection of our existing commercial historic buildings, and, hopefully, would avoid the problems referred to above.
