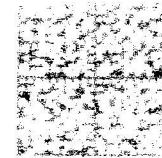

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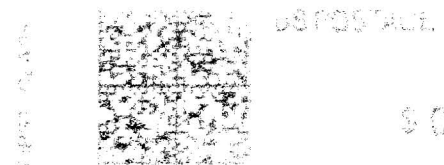

Oral and Written Testimony

The George Washington University (the “Applicant”) filed an application on September 16, 2025, requesting the Zoning Commission (“Commission”) to approve a PUD Modification with Hearing (the “Application”) pursuant to Subtitle X, Chapter 3, Subtitle Z § 300, and Subtitle Z § 704 of the Zoning Regulations (Title 11 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, “Zoning Regulations of 2016,” to which all subsequent references herein are made unless otherwise specified) for the property known as Lot 853 in Square 78 (the “Property”). The Property is within the boundaries of Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC”) 2A and across the street from ANC 2C.

The Property consists of approximately 14,450 square feet of land area and is located in the Golden Triangle Business Improvement District at the northwest corner of 20th Street, N.W. and I Street, N.W. The Property is improved with an 11-story mixed-use building with office and ground-floor retail uses. The Property is located in the D-5 zone.

The Applicant proposes to modify the PUD to (a) authorize university use in a portion of the ground floor and the upper stories of the building, and (b) authorize building identification signage (the “Project”). The Applicant requests flexibility from the number and location of short-term bicycle parking spaces to provide 36 short-term bicycle parking spaces and not locate the spaces within 120 feet of the primary building entrance.

The Office of Planning filed a setdown report dated March 2, 2026, recommending that the Commission set down the Application for a public hearing. The OP setdown report states that on balance, the Applicant’s proposal would not be inconsistent with the maps and policies of the Comprehensive Plan, including when viewed through a racial equity lens.
