Traffic Signal Warrant Analysis

The District of Columbia Department of Transportation (DDOT) has been notified that the Zoning Commission (ZC) held a public hearing for the subject project on May 24, 2007 and left the record open for the applicant to provide further information regarding DDOT's request for the applicant to conduct to a signal warrant analysis at the intersections of Elvans Road and Gainesville Street, SE and Elvans Road and Stanton Road, SE.

The applicant's traffic consultant submitted a post-hearing submission dated June 7, 2007 that included a Signal Warrant Analysis for the intersections. The DDOT-Traffic Services Administration (TSA) has reviewed the report and agrees with the findings of the study that both intersections are not warranted for traffic signals. However, the study showed many pedestrians including school children crossing Elvans Road, SE. In addition DDOT-TSA is concerned that these intersections are going to be more hazardous to pedestrians as the curvature of the roadway limits the line-of-sight between drivers and pedestrians.

DDOT-TSA recommends safety improvements at both intersections and requests the developer install new crosswalks and advanced pedestrian flashing beacons with appropriate signage to assist pedestrians crossing Elvans Road, SE. (Attachment)

Dear Mr. Bah.

I have completed my review of the traffic signal warrant study section of the report. It's unfortunate that the two intersections, Elvans Rd and Stanton Rd, S.E. and Elvans Rd and Gainesville St, S.E. are not warranted for traffic signals. These two intersections, especially Elvans Rd and Gainesville St, S.E. are going to be more hazardous in particular to pedestrians. I am concerned about the curvature of the roadway that limits the line-of-sight between drivers and pedestrians. Although it wasn't enough to meet the warrants, the study also showed many pedestrians including school children crossing Elvans Rd. It's therefore imperative that the developer installs proper crosswalks and advanced pedestrian flashing beacons occupied with signs in order to have pedestrians cross Elvans Rd. safely and with confidence. It's my hope that DDOT pushes for this to happen.

Also, from the aerial pictures, Elvans Rd doesn't look like it's a metro bus route and will be a candidate in the future due to many developments. So can you please coordinate this with MTA?
