Dear Chairperson Hood and Members of the Commission:

On July 17, 2008, EYA, LLC and the Missionary Society of Saint Paul the Apostle (collectively, "Applicant") had a public hearing for review and approval of a Consolidated Planned Unit Development ("PUD") and related Zoning Map Amendment in the above-captioned case. The Applicant provides herein the additional information requested by the Commission at the public hearing. Enclosed please find:

• Photographs of Surrounding Neighborhood

Exhibit A contains a variety of photographs taken on the streets leading into the proposed development. The architecture of the existing row houses is characterized by its variety.

• Project's Relationship to Neighborhood

Exhibit B depicts how the neighborhood feeds into, on public streets, the project.

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• Vignette of Views into Project

Exhibit C is a series of plans and perspectives that show how the new townhouses will appear to an observer as he looks into the project from the existing neighborhood.

Volumetric Study of Courtyard

Exhibit D is a perspective of a typical courtyard, showing the relationship of the open space to the buildings.

• Detailed Color Renderings with Roof Line Variety

Exhibit E is a series of detailed color renderings of Buildings 14, 27 and 28 that show the design intent of the project's architecture. No downspouts are shown because there will be none on the exterior facades of the buildings. Water from the roofs will be handled internal to the townhouses.

The renderings also show how the roof lines vary with the topography of the land.

Please note that the "hardline" drawings of these elevations, complete with dimensions and material selections, are contained in the Applicant's Pre-Hearing Submission of April 18, 2008.

• Traffic Circulation Patterns

Graphic depictions of the vehicular circulation patterns in the neighborhood, adjacent to the project's boundaries, are shown in Exhibit F.

• LEED Commitments

Attached, as Exhibit G, is the LEED checklist of items that the Applicant is committed to providing in the project.

• Additional Information Requested

The Commission requested additional information including:
(a) details of the amenities package; (b) details of the administration of the proposed scholarship fund, business grants and contributions to the Edgewood Citizens' Association; and (c) the Applicant's response to

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the Office of Planning's position with regard to the size of the affordable housing units.

Since all of these items are a part of the Applicant's Benefits and Amenities Package and, as directed by the Commission, the Applicant is in active discussion with the ANC and the community with regard to this Package, some of the amenities may well change; hence providing details in this regard may be premature.

Consequently, the Applicant requests that the Commission allow it to provide this additional information after it works through these items with the ANC and provides, as requested by the Commission, its report on the ANC consultation process.
