The Districts Fire and Emergency Medical Services supports the Mayor’s “A Plan to Close DC General: Short Term Family Housing in All 8 Wards” Initiative. We understand the Department of General Services on behalf of the Department of Human Services; will replace DC General by developing several short-term family housing facilities across the city. Each facility will include on-site wraparound services in permanent housing programs, housing search assistance, social work staff, early childhood screenings and school liaisons; education, training and employment services, health care, age appropriate recreation, essential location for meals, and financial and budget management services. The Ward 6 site has been submitted to BZA for the Proposed Use of Emergency Shelter Use designation for the program of these facilities.

We had an opportunity to review the site plan for the Ward 6 location. Upon conclusion of our review, the following is being brought forth: FEMS Office of the Fire Marshal has no objection to this development project being approved if the following requirement is adhered to: Fire access to the referenced building, site, lot and square is not compromised and is developed and maintained in accordance with *Chapter 5 Fire Service Features, Section 503 Fire Apparatus Access Roads and Appendix “D”* of the International Fire Code (IFC) 2012 edition.

As our mission is to preserve life and promote health and safety, we trust our feedback is beneficial and you find this letter in full support of your continued efforts. In the interim, we are available to address any additional questions you and or your team may have in preparation for your upcoming March 1, 2017 BZA hearing.
