I am writing in support of LAMB's location and consolidation at the Kingsbury site at 5000 14th Street NW. I support LAMB's proposed conditions of approval, and I believe that LAMB's presence at this location will be an asset for the neighborhood, Ward 4, and the District.

LAMB has worked extensively to balance its needs with the concerns and desires of the surrounding neighborhood. LAMB has been active in its outreach to and collaboration with the community, and its commitment to more than 20 conditions of approval that are directly responsive to community concerns demonstrate its commitment to being a good neighbor. Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4C has passed a resolution in support of the application. I believe this community engagement will continue once LAMB relocates to the Kingsbury site.

LAMB has made significant commitments to mitigation measures, including pedestrian infrastructure improvements at its own expense. In fact, many of LAMB's families already reside in Ward 4, which means that many students will be able to walk or bike to school. The consolidation of LAMB at one location near where many families live will promote the District's goal of reducing automobile traffic.
