To Whom It May Concern:

I understand that the current residents of the Kingsbury School are leaving. As a homeowner in Ward 4C02 I'm writing to support the relocation of the Latin American Montessori Bilingual (LAMB) school to the Kingsbury Center at 5000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W. I have lived in the neighborhood for 13 years and I strongly believe that having the LAMB school as our neighbor would be a win-win scenario for our community. I have friends in the neighborhood who attend West Elementary and LAMB. I think it would be wonderful to have two such good DCPS schools available to families in the area.

I understand that some of my neighbors are concerned about increased traffic with growth in students occupying the building. However I think that an elementary school like LAMB is our best opportunity for that space. The school has been underutilized for the years that Kingsbury inhabited it and I believe that any school or other entity would seek to increase the utilization of the space, which has a much greater capacity than its current zoning limitations. If another institution moved in, I would be more concerned. For example, a high school would bring teenagers who might drive recklessly, loiter in the neighborhood, bring drugs, etc. A health or other non-school institution might bring additional weekend traffic and activity. Therefore I very much support a school like LAMB with a strong reputation as one of the oldest and highest quality charter schools in the District to locate in that space. Moreover, our local businesses in 14<sup>th</sup> street heights could certainly use the added business brought in by LAMB families.

Therefore, I encourage you to support LAMB's request for rezoning to increase the number of students and for **support of the Board of Zoning (BZA) Application - Case Number 19851** special exemption to include building a gymnasium. The gymnasium will also serve as a community meeting space outside of school hours, which I think we need in our community.

I look forward to having the LAMB school as a neighbor and hope that the school gains the support needed from all layers of local government and community. The future of our neighborhood is dependent on having a good neighbor in the Kingsbury space and I think the LAMB school fits that role.
