I am supportive of the Acton Academy project at St. Paul's Parish. I believe it will be a beneficial to the Foggy Bottom neighborhood, and will attract and serve young families who currently lack school options nearby for their children.

I attended the April 18 ANC Meeting to voice my support for the Acton project. Given the small size of the school, I do not believe that this project will meaningfully add to noise or traffic in the neighborhood. I appreciate Acton's efforts to reach out to the neighbors and the community.

Finally, I understand that Barbara Kahlow and Sara Maddux have requested party status for the West End Citizens Association in opposition in this case, purportedly on behalf of the neighbors who live nearby St. Paul's Parish.
