## REFERRAL MEMORANDUM AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Dear ANC Single Member District Commissioner:

An Applicant within the boundaries of your ANC Single Member District is seeking zoning relief for a project or use that is not provided as a matter of right for the zoning district. This application was filed on <u>June 14, 2018</u> through the Interactive Zoning Information System (IZIS).

A public hearing has been scheduled by the Board of Zoning Adjustment (Board) on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>October 10, 2018 at 9:30 am</u>, at the Jerrily R. Kress Memorial Hearing Room, One Judiciary Square, at 441 4<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 220 South, Washington, D.C., 20001, concerning the following application:

**Application of Wisconsin Avenue Baptist Church,** pursuant to 11 DCMR Subtitle X, Chapter 9, for special exceptions under the use requirements of Subtitle U § 203.1(f), and under Subtitle C § 1402 from the retaining wall requirements of Subtitle C § 1401.3(c), and pursuant to Subtitle X, Chapter 10, for variances from the height limitations of Subtitle D § 303.1, from the lot occupancy requirements of Subtitle D § 304.1, and from the side yard requirements of Subtitle D § 307.1, to construct a new four-story church and continuing care retirement facility in the R-1-B Zone at premises 3920 Alton Place N.W. (Square 1779, Lot 14).

As described in the Zoning Regulations of the District of Columbia (Regulations), the affected ANC is an automatic party to the case and the Board gives "great weight" to its written report.
