The Nations Mosque Masjid Muhammad Inc., the Applicant for case No. BZA Tmp198. The following has been and is our public Outreach efforts. Masjid Muhammad has an assigned Neighborhood Outreach Representative that meets regularly with ANC5E and Bates Area Civic Association. Imam Talib M. Shareef and representatives has met and will continue to meet individually and collectively with neighbors, tenants and owners informing them of expansion plans. Masjid Muhammad has invited our neighbors to open house in recent years, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018. Open house affords us a time to introduce Masjid Muhammad Expansion Project. We also presented to the ANC5E on two (2) occasions, 2016 and more recently at a public meeting on December 18, 2018 at Friendship-Armstrong Public Charter.
