THE BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENT

On Wednesday, March 11, 2020, Mayor Muriel Bowser declared a State of Emergency as part of a continued effort to slow the spread of coronavirus infections in DC and the region. From Monday, March 16, 2020 through Tuesday, March 31, 2020, while the District government remains open, employees of the Office of Zoning will operate on a full telework policy.

For this reason, the Board of Zoning Adjustment will be suspending the Public Meeting for Appeal No. 20183 of The Residences of Columbia Heights, a Condominium scheduled for March 25, 2020 until further notice.

Office of Zoning staff will continue to be in contact with case parties during the closure regarding the rescheduled date for this application.

Applicants may continue to file BZA applications, but a hearing date will not be scheduled or posted until the DC Government announces resumption of office operations.
