THE BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENT

On March 11, 2020, Mayor Muriel Bowser declared a State of Emergency as part of a continued effort to slow the spread of coronavirus infections in DC and the region. As of this time, the Board of Zoning Adjustment Public Meetings and Hearings scheduled through April 25 have been suspended, but as we continue to monitor guidance from the Mayor, we are unsure when the hearings will resume.

All active cases will be rescheduled to a later date to be determined once hearings are permitted to resume.

Office of Zoning staff will continue to be in contact with case parties regarding the rescheduled dates for all applications and appeals as well as coordinating pick-up of Public Hearing Notice signs. Parties may still file documents and update application materials through IZIS or by emailing <u>bzasubmissions@dc.gov</u>. Pre-hearing submission deadlines will be adjusted based on the new hearing date.
