I am writing to strongly oppose the waiver of off-street residential and commercial parking spaces as requested by the developers of the Macklin project on Newark St and Connecticut Ave.

I still can't believe that a waiver was granted for this large project. And that an ADDITIONAL waiver is being requested.

Most of the Cleveland Park neighborhood sits *between* Connecticut and Wisconsin Aves. and is defined primarily by houses (not apts.), narrow streets, 2 schools on Macomb, 1 on Newark, plus several others nearby, with teachers and students who need parking, plus a library and a zoo.

And, yes, the metro provides transportation -- but also draws parkers from all Ward 3!
