Re: Support for the Applicant in case 20-266 "3400 Connecticut Partners LLC" for special exception relief from parking requirements.

Please support policies and practices that foster a healthy climate and a city designed for people, not automobiles.

Vote to reduce the use of cars in the city. Vote to increase safety for pedestrians and bicyclists. Vote to support public transit. Do not vote for more parking.

Macklin residents and retail customers will be within two blocks of the Metro and two cross-town bus lines (H-2&4 and D), and the L-2 bus to downtown stops right on the corner. There is plenty of access to the site without encouraging greater use of cars in Cleveland Park.

Adding parking to the neighborhood simply encourages congestion and pollution. Do not make cars a priority. Instead, make safer sidewalks, dedicated bike and bus lanes, and public transit a priority.
