The Board of Zoning Adjustment (Board or BZA) will consider the following application during the <u>virtual</u> public hearing session scheduled for <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>January 27</u>, <u>2021 beginning at 9:30 a.m.</u>, via WebEx:

Application of Peter and Karen Byrne, pursuant to 11 DCMR Subtitle X, Chapter 9, for special exceptions under the residential use provisions of Subtitle U § 601.1(d), from the alley lot use requirements of Subtitle U § 600.1(f), and under Subtitle E § 5201.3, from the side yard requirements Subtitle E § 5105.1, and from the alley centerline setback requirements of E § 5106.1, to convert an existing residential parking garage to a two-story, attached, principal dwelling unit in the RF-1 Zone at premises 514 Archibald Walk SE (Square 877, Lot 845).

PLEASE NOTE REGARDING THE HEARING SCHEDULE:

There is the possibility this case may be **RESCHEDULED OR WITHDRAWN** prior to the scheduled hearing date noted above. Therefore, it is important to confirm the hearing date, especially the day prior to the scheduled hearing. To confirm, visit the online BZA calendar at https://dcoz.dc.gov/BZACalendar. The line-up of cases on the hearing agenda and any scheduling changes to the case will be posted to the BZA calendar the day before the hearing.

Those who wish to testify at the hearing are responsible for being present when their case is called. The published line-up of cases may change on the hearing day at the Board's discretion. Therefore, it is recommended that participants arrive at 9:30 a.m. to hear the case line up. Participants may also visit https://dcoz.dc.gov/onlineServices/webcast to listen to the live broadcast of the hearing starting at 9:30 a.m. to hear the case line-up and may listen periodically throughout the hearing to see which case the Board is hearing at any point in time.

WHY YOU ARE RECEIVING THIS NOTICE

An Applicant within 200 feet of your property is seeking zoning relief for a project or use that is not allowed as a matter of right for the zoning district. The Zoning Regulations of the District of Columbia require providing notice of the public hearing at which the Applicant is scheduled to appear before the Board to present their case. You have an opportunity, if you wish, to participate in the case (see below).

HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CASE

You have the option of participating in the case through one or more of the options below:

- **A. Submit a statement into the record:** After reviewing the record, submit written testimony, either a letter in support, or a letter in opposition **before** the hearing.
 - Upload your document to the case record in IZIS or, if you have technical difficulties with IZIS, send it as a PDF attachment by email to bzasubmissions@dc.gov
 - Electronic submissions sent after 9:00 A.M. on the morning of the hearing will not be accepted into the record. Hard copy documents may be submitted to the case record by delivering in person at the time of the hearing when the case has been called by the Secretary.
- **B.** Attend the hearing and provide oral testimony as a "person in support" or "person in opposition" at the hearing.
- **C.** Apply for Party Status for more in depth involvement in the case.
 - Upload a Party Status application (Form 140) to the case record in IZIS or send to bzasubmissions@dc.gov
 - Applications for Party Status **must be filed with the Board 14 DAYS PRIOR** to the <u>originally</u> scheduled hearing date set forth in this letter.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE VIRTUAL HEARING:

A. Sign up to Testify

At least 24 hours before the virtual hearing, sign up to provide testimony.

As the Applicant, you are responsible for ensuring that your Team Members sign up to testify. This includes Agents and any proffered or accepted Expert Witnesses. It is the responsibility of all individuals wishing to testify to sign up using the "Sign Up to Testify" tab (identified by a hand symbol under "Featured Services" on the home page of the Office of Zoning website at dcoz.dc.gov)

To sign up (either as an Applicant or as an Applicant's witness), do one of the following:

Participants may sign up via the "Sign Up to Testify" tab on the Office of Zoning Home Page

- 1. Select the Hand icon under the heading **Featured Services**.
- 2. Click on the Orange Tab labeled "Sign-Up to Testify >". This will take you to the Kiosk Application.
- 3. Under Select a Type, select Board of Zoning Adjustment.
- 4. Under <u>Select an Event</u>, from the drop-down menu, choose the BZA Public Hearing date that the case is scheduled for.
- 5. Under Select a Case, from the drop-down menu, choose the BZA case from the list.
- 6. Once you have completed these steps, **a form** will appear where the participant will enter the name and contact information that will be used the day of the hearing and check the **Oath box**. Click "Submit".
- 7. Once you click submit, you will be taken to a screen that reads, "Thank you for signing-up to testify.

OR

Call BZA Staff

1. If you are unable to sign up through the online kiosk call Robert Reid at 202-727-5471 for assistance in signing up.

Confirmation of sign-up will be provided by Office of Zoning staff.

B. Submit evidence into the record:

As noted above, **all evidence** is to be submitted 21 days before the hearing, therefore, 24 hours before the hearing, all documents should be in the case file. However, if there is any supplemental documentation not already in the record as the hearing day approaches, and you intend to present it as part of your testimony, you must do **ALL** of the following:

- 1. **Upload** the document(s) into the case record in IZIS (or email to bzasubmissions@dc.gov) at least 24 hours before the hearing.
- 2. **Request** that the Board waive the 21-day filing deadline to accept the late documentation into the record (submit Form 150 or request a waiver in the document itself).)
- 3. For documents being <u>submitted during the public hearing</u>, <u>make a verbal request</u> that the Board accept the exhibit. (See Subtitle Y § 103.13(g) for applicable regulations.)
- 4. Email any <u>PowerPoint or other materials</u> that you <u>plan to present during your testimony</u>, to <u>Paul Young (Paul.Young@dc.gov)</u> prior to the hearing.

NOTE

- Hard copies of documents will not be accepted at this time.
- Documents filed either in IZIS or through <u>bzasubmissions</u> less than 24 hours before the scheduled start of the hearing session shall be **excluded** from the record.

DETAILS

To watch/listen and provide testimony on the day of the virtual hearing:

Via the Webex application:

You <u>must</u> use Chrome, Internet Explorer, or Mozilla browsers

You need a high-speed internet connection and a working camera if using video, as well as a microphone and speakers that are either connected to your computer or through a telephone.

1. Click on the URL link provided for the scheduled hearing.

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- 2. A web page should load, and the right-hand side the page should say "Join Event Now".
- 3. If the hearing has started, enter the same First name, Last name, and email address that was filled in when signing up per the instructions above. Enter the Event Password provided (if not already auto-filled in), then click "Join Now".

*Note: if the hearing has not started yet, you will not be able to join the hearing and the contact fields will be greyed out.

- 4. On the next screen, if you do not have the Webex application installed on your device, select "Run a temporary application" on your browser page.
- 5. The temporary application should download, then click the downloaded file at the bottom of the browser if it does not automatically open.
- 6. The Webex application will open and a preview screen will appear. Click "Join Event".
- 7. When initially joining the meeting, you will be muted and have "listen-only" capabilities during the Webex hearing.
- 8. When your case is called, you will then be unmuted by the Event Administrator and the Chair will specify when it is your turn to speak.

Via telephone:

- 1. Call the Webex conference phone number for the scheduled hearing using the same phone number that you provided when signing up to testify per the instructions above.
- 2. When prompted, enter the Access Code provided with the call-in number and press #.
- 3. When asked for Attendee ID number, press # again to access the meeting.
- 4. When initially joining the meeting, you will be muted and have "listen-only" capabilities during the Webex hearing.
- 5. When your case is called, you will then be unmuted by the Event Administrator and the Chair will specify when it is your turn to speak.
