Residential (R) Zones - R-1-B

The purposes of the $\underline{R-1-B \ zone}$ are to:

- Protect quiet residential areas now developed with <u>detached dwellings</u> and adjoining vacant areas likely to be developed for those purposes; and
- Stabilize the residential areas and promote a suitable environment for family life.

The R-1-B zone is intended to provide areas predominantly developed with detached houses on moderately sized lots.
