Letter to Support Pick Up Drop Off Plan for BZA Application #20488 52 Quincy PI NW

Dear Board of Zoning Adjustment Members,

This letter is written to confirm that I met with representatives from DDOT and LaShada Ham-Campbell (Petit Scholars) to discuss the Pick Up and Drop Off Plan (PUDO) and traffic safety improvements near Petit Scholars at 52 Quincy PI NW.

The following is a list of requests that were made to DDOT to improve traffic safety for the residents, students and parents. This list was shared with residents on Quincy PI NW and Florida Ave NW for their feedback.

1. Since there is a school (daycare), lower the speed limit to 15 mph on the unit block of Florida Ave NW
2. Add speed cameras - DDOT is currently looking into installing a camera on the 100 block of Florida Ave NW.
3. Hawk sign at Florida and Quincy PI NW - This request would take some time to implement since it has to be coordinated with traffic signals. A quicker solution would be to install pedestrian flashers (pedestrian activated cross signals).
4. Hawk sign at Florida and Q St NW - Same as the above.
5. Close one lane on the unit block of Florida Ave NW for pick up and drop off - This could be a longer term item as DDOT investigates options such as lane diets, which would allow for left turn lanes or PUDO lanes. The short term solution would be to designate a PUDO area on Quincy PI NW.
6. Raised cross walks on Florida Ave NW - This request would take some time to implement.
7. Close slip lane at Florida Ave NW and North Capitol St NW

Residents were asked if they preferred to designate spots for PUDO or allow patrons to use the spaces at Exxon or available parking in the area. The majority of the residents that responded agreed with Petit Scholar patrons using the parking spaces at the Exxon along with implementing some of the proposed safety improvements.
