

STATEMENT OF PUBLIC OUTREACH

Georgetown Day School (“GDS”) has been committed to working with the surrounding community, ANC 3E, and District agencies regarding the school consolidation project (the “Project”). First, GDS originally proposed the school consolidation as part of a larger Planned Unit Development (“PUD”) and was involved in community discussions from early 2015 regarding the PUD. Feedback from the PUD has been incorporated into the design for the Project. Specifically, GDS has:

- Located the new school building along 42nd Street as far away from the neighboring properties as possible to minimize impacts;
- Crafted a robust Transportation Demand Management Plan (“TDMP”) to minimize any traffic impacts from the Project; and
- Improved circulation at the Project through an access point at River Road to minimize any traffic impacts from the Project.

Additionally, GDS has engaged in numerous community and government agency meetings regarding the Project in the past few months, as listed below:

- April 19th – Meeting with Office of Planning
- April 27th – Meeting with District Department of Transportation
- June 21st – Meeting with District Department of Transportation re: Scoping Document
- June 21st – Meeting with ANC 3E Commissioners
- June 29th – Meeting with Community Groups
- July 20th – ANC 3E Meeting
- July 27th – GDS Open Community Meeting

As a result of these meetings, GDS has revised the site circulation and TDMP, as well as agreed to reasonable community access to the school, to be responsive to community concerns. GDS is committed to continuing to work with the community, ANC 3E, and District agencies regarding the Project in advance of the Board’s public hearing.
