Resolution in Support of Application of Catholic University of America ("CUA") for Amendment to an Approved Campus Plan and Further Processing of a Campus Plan for the Installation of an Accessory Solar Facility on the West Campus

WHEREAS, representatives of CUA presented plans for the installation of an accessory solar facility on the West Campus of CUA (the "Project") to Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC") 5A on October 27, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Project will support achievement of the District's renewable energy goals by increasing the supply of locally-generated, green energy to the utility grid.

WHEREAS, the Project will significantly contribute to CUA's Sustainability Plan by generating approximately 11,000 MWh per year or roughly one-fourth of the University's annual energy consumption.

WHEREAS, the solar facility will enhance stormwater management, protect Heritage Trees in the West Campus, and provide food, shelter, and pollination opportunities for insects, birds, and other wildlife.

WHEREAS, the Project will create employment and contracting opportunities throughout the District for local residents and businesses in which Catholic University has and will continue to perform outreach to the local community to inform them of these local opportunities.

WHEREAS, Catholic University is a community partner in education and has partnered with District of Columbia College Access Program to expand college access to the District's public and public charter high school students by providing scholarships that will cover the full cost of their tuition for 15 local students at Catholic University. CUA has agreed to work with ANC5A to establish criteria for selecting Ward 5/5A recipients.

WHEREAS, the solar facility will serve as a site for scheduled research, demonstration, and educational visits for the CUA community and local K-12 students.
